

Update on Safety & Risk Inventory & Evaluation (RI&E) – Erasmus School of Economics

Recently, we completed the Risk Inventory & Evaluation (RI&E) within the faculty. This forms the basis for identifying and assessing health and safety risks within our faculty.

The next step is to draw up an action plan, in which we will outline the improvement points to be addressed and the timelines for doing so.

As we are all new in these roles, we would like to carry out this process carefully and correctly. We are being supported in this by Stephan Hemme, the Health & Safety Coordinator from EUR Central.

Once the action plan is ready, we will, of course, share it with the School Council.

In addition, we will soon introduce ourselves as Prevention Officers in the upcoming ESE newsletter. In that message, we will briefly explain who we are and how colleagues can contact us with questions regarding safety or working conditions.

We are also in the process of organising a “Safety Hour” – an informal session aimed at highlighting topics such as Emergency Response (BHV), Integrated Safety, and Knowledge Security. For this, we will collaborate with colleagues from EUR Central.

We aim to hold this Safety Hour in February/March 2026.
