Working Title	Blended, hybrid and online education.
OCW Theme (basic quality)	These projects will contribute to differentiation toward needs of various student groups.
EUR Theme (innovation)	These projects will contribute to personalized and online learning in the Erasmian Classroom.
Synopsis (short description)	<p>Now that the new educational vision has been established, the CLI is keen to focus on implementing the Erasmian Classroom. Together with the schools, projects will be designed and implemented in which blended learning will be strengthened so that education can become more modern, accessible and active for regular students. On top of that, the CLI also helps teachers and schools who want to set up online courses, pre-master's and master's programmes for regular students who cannot come to campus. By doing this, we increase the flexibility and accessibility of EUR education.</p> <p>The CLI also organises projects aimed at improving and enriching assessment, for example by acquiring and implementing an e-portfolio system. The rapid development of generative AI presents EUR with new challenges in the field of testing and creates new opportunities to innovate education. The CLI coordinates the way the EUR intends to deal with these developments in education by bringing together information, people and ideas and setting up new projects together.</p> <p>The CLI also wants to pay attention to the further development of the learning environment of teachers and students. On the one hand, this happens in the digital learning environment in which we work with digital tools and technologies through which we help students to apply their knowledge to contribute to a better understanding of complex social urgencies. In addition, the CLI coordinates the vision creation and design of future learning spaces in which teaching and learning are facilitated. Through pilot projects, we try out which facilities are optimal for blended, hybrid and online teaching.</p> <p>The CLI not only sets up and implements these projects together with the schools, but also brings initiators together to share their experiences and learn from each other. This happens, among others, in the Community of Practice for Personalised and Online Learning. The CLI would like to continue these initiatives and projects with additional HEQA budget for personalised and online learning.</p>
