Topic : Selection master programmes 24-25

Introduction

Each year, the Executive Board determines the selection criteria and procedure for master's degree programmes that use selection due to capacity restrictions (WHW article 7.30b). The selection procedures are submitted to the University Council for advice.

The formal establishment of a 'selection due to capacity limitation' for an initial master's programme at EUR has a different status from the numerus fixus of the bachelor's programmes. For bachelor's programmes, there is an elaborate legal framework and a joint process with other institutions. The selection for master's programmes is a matter that the institution itself can regulate under section 7.30b of the WHW. Programmes ensure careful formulation of admission criteria that fit the objectives of the programme. In addition, programmes ensure transparent information for prospective students. In doing so, study programmes are in line with the national agreements of the Master Admission Framework (UNL, 2018).

Current developments

Until now, the Executive Board only dealt with master's programmes that select due to capacity restrictions and deans determined the admission to master's programmes that have extra qualitative admission requirements but do not select due to capacity restrictions.

Based on a sharper reading of the WHW by EUR's legal advisors, the proposal is to present the complete master's offer, including those programmes that do not select students due to capacity constraints, but do use extra admission requirements, to the Executive Board at the end of 2023. This ensures us that we are compliant. The admission and selection methods will then also be submitted to the University Council for advice. We see no risk for students: the admission requirements and procedures are clearly stated on the websites and in the Teaching and Examination Regulations, as in past years.

Applications 2024-25

In response to a call to the deans, the deans of ESL, RSM, ESSB and EMC have asked for a continuation of the capacity restriction and/or the application of additional qualitative admission requirements at a total of 18 master's programmes. The following pages provide an overview for each faculty. For the selection criteria and methods, see annexes 6 to 9.
