

Appendix 1. Proposed tuition fees 2021-2022 per student group

Students (senior years) paying full statutory tuition fees

In academic year 2021-2022, the full statutory tuition fee is €1,084 (Decision of OCW).

First-year students paying half statutory tuition fee

First-year students pay the reduced statutory tuition fees (50% of the statutory tuition fee). Due to the discount of the statutory tuition fee in the 2021-2022 academic year, first-year students pay half of the reduced statutory tuition fee in the 2021-2022 academic year. This amount is €542 (Decision of OCW).

Students paying institutional fees

The institution determines the final rate of institutional tuition fees. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Science requests the institutions of higher education to set the institutional tuition fees for academic year 2021-2022 at €1,084 lower (decision by the Executive Board). See Appendix 2 for an elaboration of this proposal.

Students paying increased statutory tuition fees (EUC)

In the academic year 2021-2022, the fee for small-scale and intensive education (increased statutory fee) will be at least €1,084 and maximum €5,421. The institution determines the final fee. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Science requests that institutions of higher education set their tuition fees at least €1,084 lower for the 2021-2022 academic year. For EUC this means that students will pay €3,316 in tuition fees in academic year 2021-2022 instead of €4,400 (decision by the Executive Board).

Premaster students

Premaster students do not pay tuition fees but a fee based on the statutory rate. This will be adjusted accordingly (decision by the Executive Board).

Students who pay a reduced institutional fee

The reduced institutional fee is equivalent to the statutory tuition fee. For 2021-2022 this will be €1,084 (OCW decision).

Students who graduate before 31 August 2021

Students who graduate from a university before 31 August 2021 will receive an amount of €535 via DUO (decision OCW).

Students graduating in February 2022

These students are entitled to a pro rata refund of tuition fees for the remaining months of academic year 2021-2022 (EUR Enrolment Regulations).

Students starting in February 2022

These students are entitled to payment of tuition fees for the remaining months of academic year 2021-2022 on a pro rata basis (EUR Enrolment Regulations).

Students who study part-time (partial statutory tuition fee)

For the part-time and dual rates, a minimum of €645 and a maximum of €1,084 will apply in academic year 2021-2022. The institution determines the final fee. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Science requests the institutions of higher education to set the rates for partial statutory tuition fees for the 2021-2022 academic year lower within the new range.

At the EUR, the partial statutory tuition fee is 100 per cent of the full statutory tuition fee. For 2021-2022 this means the partial statutory tuition fee will be €1,084 (Executive Board decision).

Students following a post-initial programme

The institution determines these tuition fees and receives no financial compensation for this. These tuition fees will remain the same as those determined for 2021-2022.
