## Questions from Councillor Lourdes Wansink Manglano regarding Threats and Intimidation of Scholars at EUR. Submitted on November 13th 2025.

- 1) To what extent does the university provide sufficient support to ensure the safety of researchers?
- 2) In this context, how do you balance the right to protest with the safety of scholars and potential forms of intimidation?
- 3) Have there been any signals from other lecturers or researchers at Erasmus University who experience similar forms of intimidation? If not known, are you willing to map this out through a staff survey or other form of inquiry?
- 4) The KNAW has found that social safety in Dutch academia is structurally declining<sup>1</sup> and therefore calls for a fundamental cultural change<sup>2</sup>. Do you support this call by the KNAW? If so, how do you plan to implement this specifically at EUR?
- 5) The Dutch government has stated that the safety of scholars is increasingly under pressure worldwide<sup>3</sup>. Can you indicate what steps you intend to take within the UNL framework to counter this development?
