#### Context

Given the upcoming budget cuts by the Dutch government, our School needs to economize. We have explored various options to reduce costs of tutorial education. In the attached memo we describe the options that, after consultation of various parties, including the Education Committee of the School Council, we consider most viable.

After summer we will discuss these measures with the Bachelor-1 and Bachelor-2 course coordinators to determine which measures can be implemented for each course and how to do this. We would like to stress that course coordinators will not be forced to, for example, go from 2 to 1 tutorial session per week. Any measures taken need to be agreed upon by the course coordinators and need to fit with the course objectives. The majority of the measures will be implemented per academic year 2026-2027. For academic year 2025-2026 we expect that we are already able to fund part of the tutorial costs from HOKA and we hope to save some money by reducing the number of TA's who only teach one tutorial group per week.

Given that some of these measures impact the set-up of our tutorial education, the Service Level Agreement Education, and the use of the HOKA money, we would like to ask your approval to implement these measures. We also welcome any advice you might have.
